

Cargill is an international producer and marketer of food, agricultural, financial and industrial products and services. Founded in 1865, the privately held company employs 131,000 people in 66 countries. The site in Mainz processes rapeseed to vegetable oil and coarse rape meal. The plant consists of two areas, namely an oil mill and a refinery where 45 employees work.

Communication and illumination in difficult conditions

Problem:

Naturally explosive atmospheres such as dust and gas occur in the oil mill and refinery sectors. This production environment demands devices that are not only gas-Ex and dust-Ex certified, but devices that are also sturdy enough to cope with the everyday activities. Another challenge is posed by the noise level generated by the various machines in the plant. This requires ear protection that provides effective sound insulation, but still enables optimum communication.

Solution:

The entire chain of communication in the Exarea has thereby been ensured.
